Iran 1951. Mossadegh Nationalism and Democracy

"All of Iran's misery, wretchedness, lawlessness and corruption over the last 50 years has been caused by oil and exportations of the oil company (Anglo-Iranian Oil Company)"

Government votes to nationalise the oil company and compensate Britain for all its investments.

"Persian oil is of vital importance to our economy. We regard it as essential to do everything possible to prevent the Persians from getting away with a breach of their contractual obligations" (Foreign Secretary Herbert Morrison)

The UK sabotaged their own nstallations, blockaded Iranian ports and requested help (without success) from the UN Security Council and the International Court of Justice.

Dulles (USA) uses new CIA to overthrow Mossadegh (anti-communism sic). Mossadegh had the abcking of 95-98 % ODF the population. US supports the Shah, overthrows the government, and sets up a puppet government.


